

How much of the time do you trust the government in Washington to do what is right? (Percent "Always" and "Most of the time" shown.)






Figure 4: A "Personnel" Problem

If you had to choose, would you rather have a smaller government providing fewer services, or a bigger government providing more services?






If you were setting priorities for the federal government these days, would you place a higher priority on...?


#### Figure 10: Partisan Gaps Over Government Spending



Considering what you get from the federal government, do you pay...












#### Figure 17: In Entitlement Debate, Most Want to Maintain Benefits





The government is facing more difficult problems than in the past






