

SEC. \_\_\_\_ . REPEAL OF RESTRICTIVE DEPOT-LEVEL MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR PROVISIONS.

(a) In General.—Sections 2460, 2464, 2466, 2469, 2470, and 2472 of title 10, United States Code, are repealed.

(b) Conforming Amendment.—The table of sections at the beginning of chapter 146 of that title is amended by striking the items relating to sections 2460, 2464, 2466, 2469, 2470, and 2472.

**Section-by-Section Analysis**

These provisions currently impose limitations on the management of depot-level maintenance and repair by requiring certain amounts of work be performed in public depots, restrict the ability to effectively manage the public depot workforce, and impede the ability to reassign workload currently performed at a public depot. These arbitrary limitations reduce the flexibility necessary for the Department to make proper and efficient business decisions in determining the best source for depot-level maintenance and repair. Repeal of these provisions will enable the Department to seek the most efficient and cost effective source of support for the warfighter.
