1           (b) VETERANS PREFERENCE ELIGIBILITY.—Section  
2 2108(1) of title 5, United States Code, is amended by  
3 striking “separated from” and inserting “discharged or  
4 released from active duty in”.

5           (c) SAVINGS PROVISION.—Nothing in the amendment  
6 made by subsection (b) may be construed to affect a deter-  
7 mination made before the date of enactment of this Act  
8 that an individual is preference eligible (as defined in sec-  
9 tion 2108(3) of title 5, United States Code).
