Dr. Celia Merzbacher is a Senior Director at SRI International and Deputy Director of the Quantum Economic Development Consortium (QED-C), a consortium that aims to enable and strengthen the U.S. commercial quantum industry. QED-C is supported by the U.S. Department of Commerce's National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) and a cross-section of the quantum ecosystem from industry, academic, and other sectors.

Prior to joining SRI, Dr. Merzbacher was Vice President for Innovative Partnerships at the Semiconductor Research Corporation, a consortium of the semiconductor industry. In 2003-2008, she was Assistant Director for Technology R&D in the White House Office of Science and Technology Policy and Executive Director of the President's Council of Advisors on Science and Technology (PCAST). She has served as Chair of the National Materials and Manufacturing Board of the National Academies of Science, Engineering and Medicine, on the Board of Directors of ANSI, and is on advisory boards of several university research centers.
