Key Developments: 62,800+ DoD personnel supporting COVID relief

- **U.S. Northern Command** is responsible for DoD's support of COVID-19 efforts with approximately 13,700 people deployed, including 2,400 medical personnel.
- 46,500+ members of the **National Guard** are supporting COVID-19 response at the direction of their governors. State priorities are focused on testing and screening, especially as states prepare to reopen, as well as providing logistical support through warehousing and distribution of medical supplies and food.
- The **U.S. Army Corps of Engineers** is executing 38 FEMA Mission Assignments totaling \$1.8 billion, with 15,000 personnel engaged and 1,109 deployed in support of COVID-19 response operations.
- The **Defense Logistics Agency** has executed 6,036 contract actions with \$667.3 million in obligations for COVID-19 support, including \$628 million directly supporting FEMA and HHS requirements.
