

NAVY COVID-19 UPDATE

April 16, 2020

Key Developments

- As of today, 94% of USS Theodore Roosevelt crewmembers have been tested for COVID-19, with 655 positive and 3,919 negative results. 4,059 Sailors have moved ashore.
- Six Sailors assigned to USS Theodore Roosevelt are in U.S. Naval Hospital Guam being treated for COVID-19 symptoms. One of those Sailors is in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) for increased observation due to shortness of breath.
