

Dr. Heather Roff is a Senior Research Analyst at JHU/APL, an Associate Research Fellow at the Leverhulme Centre for the Future of Intelligence at the University of Cambridge, and a nonresident Fellow in Foreign Policy at the Brookings Institution. Prior to joining APL, Dr. Roff was a research scientist at Deepmind, a Senior Research Fellow in the Department of Politics & International Relations at the University of Oxford, and has held several faculty posts at the University of Denver, the University of Waterloo, and the US Air Force Academy. Prior fellowships include being a National Cybersecurity fellow and a Future of War Project fellow at the New America Foundation. She is author to numerous articles as well as the monograph, *Global Justice, Kant and the Responsibility to Protect* (Routledge 2012). She is a recognized expert on autonomous weapons systems, testifying multiple times to the United Nations Convention on Certain Conventional Weapons, and a Special Governmental Expert on AI Ethics for the Defense Innovation Board.
