

Matt Quinn is the Science Director for the Army's Telemedicine & Advanced Technology Research Center (TATRC). Prior, he served as Senior Advisor for Health Technology at the Health Resources & Services Administration (HRSA). Previously, Matt was the East Coast Managing Director for Intel's Healthcare and Life Sciences business and Director of Healthcare Initiatives for the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). He led efforts at NIST and AHRQ to improve the usability and accessibility of health IT and to realize the value of health IT in emerging models of care delivery.
